RE: Response to September 18, 1987 Conditional Mid-Term Permit Approval, Belina Complex, Valley Camp of Utah, ACT/007/001, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

Summary

The above-mentioned submittal, received October 30, 1987, has been reviewed. In response to various conditions to the Mid-Term Permit Approval, the mention of purchasing topsoil was inadvertently included in the text. The purchase of topsoil was not part of the approved Mid-Term Permit. Suitable growth material reclamation management will be formulated based on the results of the field test plots required under Conditions 5 and 6 of the approved permit. The above-mentioned submittal must be updated to reflect this direction in reclamation soil management.

Recommendation

Delete all verbage from the above-mentioned submittal that describes the purchase of topsoil. Specific areas of edit include Section 784.13, pages 8 and 9; and Appendix M, Methodology, phase #1 Earth Moving.
