

RE: Certification of Ponds, Federal NOV 88-2-116-2, Belina Mine Complex, Valley Camp Coal Company, ACT/007/001, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

The terms of the conditional approval issued by the Division on 8/5/88 have been met by the operator. A complete and accurate certification of the ponds has been submitted by the operator in accordance with conditional approval for abatement of Federal NOV 88-2-116-2.

In accordance with Federal NOV 88-2-116-2, the operator was required to submit a complete and accurate Registered Professional Engineer's certification for ponds 1, 2, 3, and 4. Certification of the ponds was submitted to the Division on 8/5/88. OSMRE terminated violations 1 and 2 on 8/8/88 accordingly, based on conditional approval by the Division.

Current standing for the stipulations regarding the conditional approval for the sediment ponds for Valley Camp are as follows:

Stipulation 1 - Soil samples for determination of stability of the embankments were received by the Division on October 19, 1988. Extension of the time allowed for the submittal of this information was granted by Sue Linner in as much as the laboratory results had not been received by the operator at the due date for the stipulation. The requirements of this stipulation have now been met by the operator.

Stipulation 2 - As-Built drawings have been received from the operator. Completion of the cleaning of sediment ponds 1, 2 and 3 occurred on November 10, 1988. As-builts of the above ponds were submitted to the Division for review on February 3, 1989. In review of those designs, information provided on some of the drawings was found to be in conflict with information provided in the design. These drawings were resubmitted to the Division on March 10, 1989.
