Summary:

Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. submitted the first four updated Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) chapters for permit renewal on June 30, 1989. This package was reviewed for completeness of the legal/financial information (Chapter R614-301-100, Permitting). The submittal was found to be deficient as outlined in the following section.

Analysis:

UMC 771.25 Permit Fees - SCL
(R614-301-118)

There is no evidence of a \$5.00 fee being submitted with the package. However, this is not considered necessary for permit renewal. This section should be revised to show it is not applicable.

UMC 771.27 Verification of Application - SCL
(R614-301-123)

A verification of application must be part of the resubmitted MRP.

UMC 782.17 Permit Term Information - SCL
(R614-301-116)

This section should contain a reference to a map which shows the starting and termination date of each phase of mining which has been completed, and which will be undertaken during the term of the renewal.

UMC 782.19 Identification of Other Licenses and Permits - SCL

The NPDES permit, Air Quality Approval letter, and the letter from the State Historic Preservation Officer, determining no sites eligible for the National Register, should be provided as part of the MRP.

UMC 782.20 Identification of Location of Public Office for Filing of Application - SCL
(R614-300-121.200)

This section has not been addressed.

UMC 782.21 Newspaper Advertisement and Proof of Publication - SCL
(R614-300-121)

The newspaper advertisement must show that a copy of the application is available for public review at the Division's Salt Lake office.

Recommendations:

Chapter R614-301-100 should not be approved until the applicant has addressed the above deficiencies.
