On February 3, 1989, the Division received a report entitled "Analysis of Sediment Pond Design and Hydrologic Analysis of Undisturbed Area Bypass Channels and Small Exemption Areas" prepared by Hansen Allen and Luce Inc. for Valley Camp. Part of that report contained information pertinent to federal Ten-Day Notices (TDN's) for pond certifications and small area exemptions. Adequacy of these areas has been addressed as amendment reviews.
