Re: Mine Permit Renewal Application Schedule; May 1, 1990 meeting held at the Division office in SLC, Utah.

In attendance were: Mr. Daron Haddock, Mr. Randall Harden, Mr. Rick Summers, Mr. Lynn Kunzler, Mr. Henry Sauer for the Division and Mr. David Hansen of Hansen, Allen and Luce, Mr. Ed Sanderson of Sand Design & Graphics and Mr. Steven K. Tanner for Valley Camp of Utah, Inc.

Due to unforeseen workloads and the conversion to the New State Regulations, there have been unexpected delays from both parties, which has made the mandated schedule an impossible situation to meet in a timely manner.

As discussed during the meeting, this particular Mine Permit Renewal Application is the first to be attempted under the new regulations, both administrative and Valley Camp delays have occurred, particularly in the Hydrology (R614-301-700) and the Engineering Section (R614-301-500). Interpolation and redundancy of the Regulations have slowed the process far more than anticipated by either party.

This letter is to serve as a formal request for a meeting to establish a reasonable schedule for both the Division and Valley Camp to complete this Mine Permit Renewal Application.
