Re: Determination of Completeness, Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. Belina Complex, Permit Renewal, ACT/007/001, Folder #2, Carbon Co. Utah

The Utah Division of Oil, Gas and Mining (Division) has completed a review of the revised Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) for the Belina Complex. The Division has determined the plan to be administratively complete. In compliance with Section R614-300-121.300 of the Utah Coal Mining Reclamation Act (UCA Section 40-10-1 et seq), notice is hereby given to all appropriate agencies having a jurisdiction over or an interest in the area of the operations that a complete plan is available for public review.

Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. is proposing to renew its permanent program mining permit for the Belina Complex. No new areas are proposed to be added to the permitted area and no new surface disturbances are proposed for the new permit term.

The permit area is located in Carbon and Emery Counties, Utah approximately 2 miles south of Scofield, Utah, and is accessible via State Highway 96. The permit area extends from Green Canyon on the North to Cox Canyon on the South.

The Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will now prepare a Technical Analysis (TA) to determine whether the plan meets all the criteria of the Permanent Program Performance Standards according to the requirements of UCA, Section 40-10-1 et seq.

Upon completion of the TA for said plan, a decision will be made as to approval or disapproval of the permit renewal application. No decision will be taken by the Director for a minimum period of 30 days after submission of this Notice of Availability to the appropriate agencies. 
