Re: Response to TDNX-90-02-107-9, Belina Mine Complex, Valley Camp of Utah, ACT/007/001, Carbon County, Utah

Summary:

The above referenced TDN (received July 2, 1990) was issued for failure to conduct coal mining and reclamation operations only on those lands specifically designated as the permit area....the truck approach SAE at the ValCam loadout.

This area was noted as a deficiency in our review for the repermitting of the Belina Complex. The operator adequately addressed this issue with the submittals of March 23 and June 14, 1990. Map R614-301-100 (Permit Area Base Map) depicts the approach area within the permit area. Map R614-301-526.100 (ValCm Loadout Facility - As-built) depicts the area within the approved disturbed area. Map R614-301-731.720a (ValCam Sediment Control Facilities) depicts the truck approach area as ASCA area #2. The permit narrative (Chapter 7, section R614-301-742.240) describes this area and proposes several treatment measures for the drainage (primarily straw bales/catch basin).

The permit issued to Valley Camp Coal of Utah, Inc. effective July 5, 1990 approved these maps and narrative.
