Re: Approval To Install Subsidence Control Stations, Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., Belina Complex, ACT/007/001, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division received a verbal request from Valley Camp Coal Company in May 1991 to install subsidence control stations in boardinghouse canyon. The need for subsidence monitoring in Boardinghouse Canyon was also identified by Manti-LaSal National Forest. The proposal was subsequently reviewed by David Darby of the Division's technical staff.

The Division hereby approves the request to install subsidence control stations in Boardinghouse canyon. This approval does not authorize any mining other than what is specified in the current mining and reclamation plan submitted October 10, 1990. It is the Division's understanding that mining plans proposed beneath Boardinghouse Creek are being reviewed by the Bureau of Land Management. The Division and the Manti-LaSal Forest Service are awaiting notification of mine plan feasibility beneath Boardinghouse Creek. Formal submittal of any mine plan changes should be submitted as soon as possible to expedite Division review. Thank you for your cooperation in this matter.
