4d. Diversions

Steven Tanner stated that the sediment had been removed from behind the strawbales shortly after the July inspection. There have been other storms since the clean out. Some sediment has accumulated behind the strawbales as the result of recent runoff. The operator was reminded to preform regular maintenance of the strawbales. No violation has taken place.

8 Noncoal Waste

Small amounts of litter were present at the loadout facility. Steve Tanner stated that he would have someone police the area. No violation has taken place.

10 Slides and Other Damage

Subsidence cracks are still present in Boardinghouse Canyon. Steve Tanner stated that the area will be walked in September to determine if any cracks have occurred and the extent of "natural" healing that has occurred to subsided areas.
