Re: Mid-Term Review, Valley Camp of Utah, Belina Complex, ACT/007/001, Folder 3#, Carbon County, Utah

Due to the coal market, Valley Camp has reduced the work force to a minimum. Valley Camp's Belina No. 2 mine is still idled and only shipping a limited amount of coal. Due to the continuing circumstances, and limited personnel, the January 18, 1993 due date you graciously granted Valley Camp, will not be achievable.

Valley Camp hereby respectfully requests the due date be extended to February 10, 1993 for the submittal. This would allow the time needed to generate the 8 additional maps required for the 200 and 300 Sections and make the required revisions and those nomenclature revisions requested by the inspectors. A draft of the revised text will be compiled next week to review the continuity of the text, appendicies, and maps. I have advised each tech staff member in the past, that should an important environmental concern arise, we would certainly be willing to discuss it with them, preferably before we go to press with the submittal.
