Re: Modification to Water Quality Sampling Program, Valley Camp of Utah,
Belina Mine, ACT/007/001, Folder #3, Carbon County, Utah

The Division has completed a review of your submittal dated July 12, 1993, which requested a change in the Water Monitoring Requirements for the Belina Mine. The parameters you have asked to be removed from the monitoring requirements are consistent with Division guidelines and the changes are hereby accepted.

It was noticed, however, that the monitoring requirements for total iron and total Manganese may need to be increased to be consistent with R645-301-731.200. At the present time your schedule calls for monitoring total iron only once at high flow and total manganese only once at high flow and once at low flow. The regulations call for submitting data for these parameters at least every three months. You may want to revise your monitoring schedule to reflect that requirement.
