Dear Ms. Dragoo:

This letter is in response to your letter dated November 9, 1993 concerning Whites Oak's application for permit transfer and summarizes the Division's understanding of what remains to be done in order to effectuate the permit transfer.

There are essentially two items which must be completed prior to the Division being able to approve the transfer. They are:

- 1) A suitable bond and reclamation agreement in the name of the applicant must be on file with the Division. The present bond and reclamation agreement are in the name of Valley Camp and would not be acceptable once the transfer has been consummated.
- 2) Clearance through the Applicant Violator System (AVS) must be completed. At the present time we are waiting for clearances from the States of Kentucky and Ohio. It is our understanding that Marilyn Halbert would contact these states and facilitate this process.

With the completion of these two items the Division would be in a position to approve the permit transfer. Any other remaining issues (technical in nature) could be completed after the transfer by stipulation.
