



This letter is submitted as a follow-up to our telephone conversation of today concerning my letter to James Carter of November 3, 1994. First, I appreciate your prompt response to my letter.

Second, this will confirm that, to date, White Oak Mining Company has not submitted a new mine plan nor any request for an expansion of the existing mine plan regarding the coal beneath the surface of the Telonis family properties.

Third, with respect to any future plans which may be submitted by White Oak Mining Company it is my understanding that I will be afforded an opportunity to comment thereon, as attorney-in-fact for the Telonis family.

To verify my continued interest in this matter, I enclose herewith a copy of the Power of Attorney document executed by my clients authorizing me to represent them in any matters dealing with their real property holdings in Carbon County, Utah. The document serves another purpose in that it also establishes the legal description of the land under which White Oak Mining Company may commence mining operations sometime in the future.

I would appreciate hearing from your office regarding any effort by White Oak Mining Company to begin mining operations beneath the Telonis family properties surface.
