4d. Water samples were taken earlier in the week and results of analyses were not available at the time of inspection.


4e. Pond 004A discharged for several days in late March. One water sample was analyzed. Iron (1.07 mg/l) exceeded the daily allowable limit of 1 mg/l. TDS (996 mg/l) exceeded the 30 day average of 700 mg/l, but did not exceed the daily maximum of 1000 mg/l. Mark Schmitz at Utah DEQ was notified of exceedance of the permit discharge limitations by a letter from White Oak Mining and Construction dated April 5, 1994.

21. An Acord form on file with DOGM identifies Valley Camp Coal Company, including Valley Camp of Utah, Inc., as being insured by liability policies GLR9085595 and BAF160175. The expiration date on these policies is shown as April 1, 1994. A second Acord form on file with DOGM names White Oak Mining and Construction Company as being insured by liability policies 3710-45-17 and BAP7320-38-21, which expire September 16, 1994. A copy of this second Acord form was presented at the mine office during the inspection as proof of liability insurance. White Oak Mining and Construction is the operator of the mine, but Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. is the permittee.
