2. Disturbed area boundary markers were freshly painted and easily located at the loadout in Pleasant Valley. At the mine office in Pleasant Valley, stakes or roof bolts were seen west of the road but not to the east. The markers were assumed to mark a section of the disturbed area boundary but were not painted as described in the PAP. No boundary markers could be located at three areas checked at the mine site and haul road: 1) where the coal haul road joins county road 264, which includes a stretch of Eccles Creek, 2) where culvert C-25-36 passes under the coal haul road, and 3) the open area west of the north end of UDD-3 and the trees north of the west end of UDD-2.

No sign showing the name, business address, and telephone number of the permittee was found at the point of access from the public road to the mine office in Pleasant Valley.

The buffer zone along Eccles Creek, near where the haul road joins county road 264 and the disturbed area crosses Eccles Creek, is not marked with a buffer zone sign.

Notice of Violation 94-43-2-1 was issued for not having clearly marked disturbed area boundaries, not having an identification sign at the mine office, and not marking the buffer zone along Eccles Creek.

4b. Sediment pond 004A was not discharging but the water was within 1/4 inch of the lip of the outlet.

4d. Results of water analyses were not available. These will be checked as part of the June partial inspection.

5. Two explosives caches have been moved onto the mine site in anticipation of tunneling through an igneous dike, but no explosives have been brought to the site as yet. Mechanical tunneling is being considered as an alternative to blasting, so explosives may not be needed.

9. Marmots were spotted at several locations within and adjacent to the disturbed area. Trout were seen in Eccles Creek just below where the haul road joins county road 264.

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19. Legal and financial information up to date as of last three months. Transfer of permit to White Oaks Mining and Construction is pending and expected before next inspection.


