The Division has recently processed an application for transfer of the Belina Mine Permit from Valley Camp of Utah to White Oak Mining and Construction Company. The transfer has not yet been finalized as we are presently waiting to receive a reclamation bond in White Oak's name before completing the transfer.

In the interim we have been notified that White Oak is operating the Belina Mine under Valley Camp's permit. This situation needs to be identified in the 100 section of Valley Camp's plan so that the plan clearly shows the operating conditions at the mine. A Division Order is enclosed requiring Valley Camp to revise the 100 section of the Permit Application Package. Please note that you have 30 days in which to respond.

ORDER & FINDINGS
of
PERMIT DEFICIENCY

PERMIT NUMBER ACT/007/001
DIVISION ORDER # 94A

PURSUANT to R645-303-212, the DIVISION ORDERS the PERMITTEE, Valley Camp of Utah, Incorporated, to make the permit changes enumerated in the findings of permit deficiency in order to be in compliance with the State Coal Program. These findings of permit deficiency are to be remedied in accordance with R645-303-220.

FINDINGS OF PERMIT DEFICIENCY

The Division finds the permit deficient in that Section 100 of the Permittee's Permit Application Package does not accurately describe the operating arrangement at the mine. Although correspondence identifies White Oak Incorporated as operator this arrangement is not identified in the plan.

Regulation Cited: R645-301-112, R645-300-142

Requirements

In order to comply with these regulations, the permittee must revise the 100 section of the Permit Application Package to accurately reflect the Valley Camp of Utah and White Oak operations for the Belina Mine. (Names, Addresses, and Ownership and Control Relationships must be identified.)

ORDER

Valley Camp of Utah, Inc. is ordered to make the requisite permit changes in accordance with R645-303-220 and to submit a complete application for permit change to address the findings of permit deficiency within 30 days of date of the Order. Approval by the Division must be obtained within 60 days of date of this Order. All approvals not obtained within 60 days may result in a hindrance violation.
