NOTICE OF VIOLATION NO. N 94-43-2-1

Violation No. 1 of 1

Nature of violation

Disturbed Area Boundary (perimeter of all areas affected by surface operations or facilities) is not clearly marked at the mine site in Whiskey Canyon, including the coal haul road, or at the Mine Office in Pleasant Valley. The stream buffer zone along Eccles Creek is not marked. There is no identification sign. There is no identification sign at the point of access to the mine office from the public road.
