SUMMARY:

As part of the White Oak Mines midterm review, the Division has reviewed alternate sediment control measures. This memorandum addresses the review of these measures.

ANALYSIS:

Alternate sediment control areas (ASCAs) are discussed on pages 91 through 100 of the MRP. In this section it says that there are six ASCAs in the Wildcat Loadout operations. These are shown on Maps R645-301-521.124 numbers 1, 2, 3 and 4, and designed in Appendix 742.310. The measures used for treating ASCA consist of silt fence, pavement, gabions, straw bales, and vegetation. The designs are adequate to meet the requirement of the regulations and follow Division policy according to Directive Tech-003A.

FINDINGS:

The Alternate sediment control information in the MRP is complete and accurate.

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RECOMMENDATION:

The alternate sediment control measure information provided in the White Oak MRP is complete and accurate. This information fulfills all requirements for the alternate sediment control portion of the midterm review.

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
