SUBJECT: Stipulations 6 Post Mining Land Uses

Dear Ms. Grubaugh-Littig:

Lodestar Energy, Inc. is requesting another extension until July of 2003 to complete this stipulation. The Oman heirs have not cooperated in providing the necessary documentation to resolve this issue. Our efforts to date have consisted of the May letter from Eb Davis to Frank Patrick – Oman heirs' attorney outlining the issues that need to be resolved. The visit by the Oman heirs to the mine site June 14th to inspect the site and the locate the jeep trail issue. After they did not get back on the land use and jeep trail across the reclamation, certified letters were mailed in August and October reiterating the issues that need resolution. Frank Patrick – Oman heirs' attorney contacted me October 23th requesting either a letter from Lodestar that allowed him to communicate with me on the issues or an attorney contact since Eb Davis had left the company at that time. The bankruptcy attorneys felt that Mr. Patrick should deal with Lodestar through them. Information detailing the bond estimate for the haulroad reclamation was faxed to both Frank Patrick Oman's attorney and Jeffrey Marks – Bankruptcy attorney. My last contact was with Mr. Marks on December 3rd requesting Mr. Patrick's mailing address.
