Dear Mr. Miller:

Thank you for meeting with representatives from the Forest Service and us onsite at the Sinkhole Item #23 on Friday, June 28, 2002. (You met with the BLM on Thursday, June 27, 2002). It was agreed onsite that you would mitigate the "hazards" at this sinkhole, including some backfilling, reshaping and revegetating slopes. It was understood by all parties that access to this sinkhole would require tramping equipment over land which may include the removal of some trees. You agreed that an amendment to describe this proposed mitigation activity would be submitted by the end of July 2002.

There were also discussions that there are about 60 other subsidence features on Forest Service property within the White Oak Mine permit area. This is the only feature, however, that requires mitigation at this time.
