Lodestar Energy, Inc. is submitting three (3) copies of the revisions required in Stipulation #6 of the permit approval. The maps and verbiage sections of the permit that referred to the jeep trail access have been modified to reflect the Supplemental Agreement in Appendix 1-2. The Oman's have not provided an updated comment letter. However, Lodestar believes that the highlighted portion on Pages 2 and 3 of the Amended Lease Agreement with the Oman's, that is included in Appendix 1-2, addresses the wishes of the landowner relating to the disturbed areas of the land leased to Lodestar. This statement is binding until the landowner's comments reflect a change in the land use. The C1 and C2 forms clearly identify where these documents are to be inserted into the permit.


