1. PERMITS, CHANGE, TRANSFER, RENEWAL, SALE

Blue Ridge Services were cleaning and grading roads within the pit area. The mine site was covered with approximately two feet of snow in the few days. In addition to opening roadways, the operator was hauling spoil from the upper pit to the highwall adjacent to the pit.

The permittee loaded out one unit train last night, leaving the coal yard with a small amount of coal.

4A. HYDROLOGIC BALANCE: DIVERSIONS

The main disturbed diversion was recently cleanout by the operator (Blue Ridge Services). No considerable amount of water was flowing during the inspection.

7. COAL MINE WASTE/REFUSE PILES/IMPOUNDMENTS

The operator was removing spoil from the upper pit area. Blue Ridge Services was placing this material against the highwall adjacent to the upper pit.
