Bill,

Mr. White has given me a proposal to map the site. He says it would cost \$2070 to establish enough control in the area to map from. Some of that may have already been accomplished by Mark Wayment, I am working on getting the two in touch with each other.

Once that is established, it would cost \$2160 to provide a digital map at 5' contours and \$2890 to establish a digital map at 2' contours. The 2' contours would be preferable.

The reference to "most of the main pit" meant that everything in the second photo could be accurately mapped, since there is overlap. The rest of the area may be off somewhat because we don't have overlapping photos. The areas with no overlap coverage are to the North where just the topsoil has been stripped and there is a temporary topsoil pile, and to the south where just the topsoil has been stripped.

Please let me know if you have any questions, or if you would like me to proceed in gathering more information from Mr. White.
