**Subject:** Boardinghouse Subsidence inspection.

Today, Pete Hess and I inspected the subsidence area just inside the FS boundry in Boardinghouse Canyon. The vegetations is doing very well with native grasses 2 to 3 feet tall as well other natives species. There is aspen regeneration occurring as well. The ground appears to have sabilized as a result of the back filling that was done 2 years ago.

Pete and I removed the fence.

We will plan to return to the area next year for a follow-up inspection.
