Hello All:

I spoke with Rick Wilde in the Division of Water Rights Price Office today about whether or not a stream alteration permit would be required for the repair work at White Oak. The previous permit was issued in 2000 and expired in 2003. It was initially issued to Lodestar for the purpose of mining coal under the streambed. Rick indicated that a new permit **would** be required for the type of work that we plan to do.

Louis - I am copying you on this because I wanted to make sure there was no other outstanding stream alteration permit information out there that may have been done by your group. Could you let me know?

The permit application requires some maps and a wetland delineation if our area includes wetlands. I can get started on it with DOGM listed as the applicant, unless there are objections. One important point to mention is that the permit application is currently free but as of July 1, 2009, they will begin charging fees (which for State/Federal agencies is going to be around \$200.00). So there is still some time to get this done before the fees are instituted. Please let me know if you would like me to proceed with this permitting.
