Reclamation of the White Oak Mine was completed by the Division of Oil Gas and Mining in 2005 with funds made available through the bankruptcy Trustee for the Lodestar Energy, Inc. To access the documents you must use the login "ogmguest" and the password "ogmguest", without quotation marks.

To conduct monthly inspections, the Division requires access to monitor the loadout and mine sites. At this time, both the loadout and mine site gates are locked. Please provide the Division with a key to the locks or we may choose to install our own separate locks in order to make the site accessible by vehicle. If you would like to receive the monthly inspection reports, please provide us with your email contact information.

At this time, the loadout site is stable and vegetation is improving. The Whiskey Creek Canyon mine site requires additional work and the Division plans to return to the site to fill a subsidence void and improve stability of the steepest reach of the stream channel. We welcome landowner input on this reclamation activity. Please call Priscilla Burton (435) 613-3733 for further information about accessing files, to receive inspection reports by email, to discuss mine site reclamation work and to arrange for Division access to the loadout and mine sites.
