





WHITE OAK STABILIZATION PROJECT SUMMARY

The project is located in a side canyon in Eccles Canyon approximately 4 miles south of Scofield on State Highway 39. There is a 1.5 miles paved road leading up the Whiskey Creek drainage to the reclaimed mine site. The site was formerly an underground mine site known over the years as the Belina Mine, the Valley Camp Mine, and finally the White Oak Mine. The portals to the upper and lower seams were sealed and in 2001 the mining method changed to surface mining. Surface mining was abandoned in 2003. The site and the intermittent stream were reclaimed in 2005. Two one-hundred year storms in 2007 caused severe erosion of the channel and many large gullies on the south facing slopes.

The WORK consists of four primary tasks:

- 1) The construction of three terraces and application of soil amendments (hay mulch and biosolids) to stabilize the south facing slopes and to provide organic matter to the mostly barren overburden and installation of erosion control logs in the major gullies.
- 2) The backfilling of three subsidence voids believed to be located above sealed underground portals.
- 3) The stabilization of the entrenched sections of the reclaimed Whiskey Creek intermittent stream channel using rock drop structures and stilling pools, and by widening the channel in its steepest gradient, and
- 4) Revegetation, including seeding and planting of containerized plants along the terraces, above erosion control logs, and along the length of the streambank.

Division staff met with the landowner on Tuesday July 13, 2010 to explain the proposed WORK. There was a good exchange of information and the landowner appeared pleased to see improvements begin.
