3. Topsoil

Topsoil pile at the Loadout is stable.

4.b Hydrologic Balance: Sediment Ponds and Impoundments

Loadout pond contains water. Thin ice is on the pond.

4.c Hydrologic Balance: Other Sediment Control Measures

Sediment from the logging road is contributing to road drainage.

8. Noncoal Waste

Rail road ties and discarded fluid cans are piled along the RR access road at the Loadout.

11. Contemporaneous Reclamation

Repaired culvert area at the Loadout is mostly free of snow. Small clumps of grasses noted.

13. Revegetation

Saturated soils should provide a flush of growth this spring.

16.a Roads: Construction, Maintenance, Surfacing

Small sink hole (9 " diameter) on the access road to the Loadout pond was noted.

16.b Roads: Drainage Controls

Could not reach much of the drainage controls along the mine access road. Logging road is contributing sediment that drains to the creek.

Spoke with Joe Fielder, Logger, who was on site, about the July 23, 2013 weed spray day.
