Hello Mr Stapley,

We spoke yesterday about an upcoming reclamation project that will remove the asphalt access road going up Whiskey Creek. The reclamation may also remove a culvert in Eccles Creek which is buried beneath a pad at the entrance to the haul road, adjacent to State Hwy 264. The culvert is located about 2 miles west of the Skyline Mine Loadout. (See the attached google image of the location and photos of the pad.)

The mining and reclamation plan which was written in 2001 outlines removal of the culvert, but also suggests that this culvert may be within UDOT's right of way and may be used by UDOT for the purpose of snow storage. DOGM is preparing specifications for the work and would like to know whether the pad should remain for use by UDOT for snow storage. If UDOT would like the pad and culvert to remain, DOGM will need assurance that UDOT will accept responsibility for the culvert.
