7/31/2017. Owners of 15 lots I Clear Creek and the homeowner's association (for common areas) returned participation forms.

8/1/2017. Skyline CWMA (Carbon County weed, and Utah Division Oil Gas & Mining staff) sprayed Platoon (2,4-D) herbicide on oxeye daisy in common areas and participating landowners lots. One additional landowner gave verbal approval for treatment.

8/2/2017. One additional MOU was received authorizing treatment, making a total of 17 lots.

8/15/2017. Skyline CWMA members returned to conduct a second spray of 17 lots and common areas with Platoon.

8/31/2017. Skyline CWMA members delivered to each participant's lot(s): a flat containing six-packs of alpine aster, black-eyed Susan, blanket flower, columbine, coreopsis, delphinium, and yarrow. In addition, 13 extra flats were left for planting in the common areas.

9/7/2017. Received voice message from Ted Helsten, Vice President, Clear Creek Homeowners Association, stating that all plants had been planted.
