On October 29, 1982, an inspection of the above-mentioned facilities was conducted by Ken Wyatt and Barton Kale of the Division. The purpose of this inspection was to examine for reclamation work of the recent exploration activities and to familiarize Mr. Kale with the proposed development areas.

At this time there was no activity observed in any of Sunedco's proposed development sites. Recent activity included bulk sampling from the old mine workings in Dugout and Fish Creek Canyon. At this time any portals that had been opened up were backfilled. The drill site located up Corbuld Canyon had been recontoured and seeded. All of these areas have previously been disturbed before the enactment of SMCRA in 1977. Mines located in Dugout Canyon and Fish Creek were the Knight-Ideal Mine and the Spring Canyon Mine respectively. Mining commenced in this area around 1906. No additional disturbances were created by this exploration work.
