On Wednesday, June 29, 1983, Susan Limmer (biologist) and Doug Maier (geologist) were shown the mine planned drill sites for 1983 by Sunedco representatives Charlie Durrett (environmental coordinator), Sam Sublett (geologist) and Mark Terrell (assistant). The main purpose of the visit was to check for any adverse conditions regarding environmental protection and to communicate to the operator any concerns of DOGM with the Sage Point-Dugout Canyon drilling project.

Weather conditions were mild and all but one drill site was visited. Without the benefit of the BLM's final analysis of the project, no objections were made about hole locations or drilling and reclamation techniques. The sites should be inspected next spring to evaluate the reclamation success.
