Gentlemen:

Price River Coal Company requests a variance from the Surface Mining Provisions requiring the placing of cross drains in the Sowbelly Gulch access road.

Historically, drainage along this road has been maintained on both sides of the road to its junction with Spring Canyon - at this point, both drainages merge into Spring Canyon.

Placing cross drains in this road will only serve to break up an established road bed, which will cause more erosion, as well as increasing the cost of drainage control and final reclamation.

Current plans call for phasing out operations in Sowbelly in about four years.
