This letter is to confirm the matters discussed among Jim Dykman, Bill Killam and yourself on April 23, 1981.

C&W #1 Mine Plan (UT 0036)

- 1) OSM will require a cultural resources survey on all previously undisturbed land that will be directly impacted by mining related activities.
- 2) Based on information presented by Jim Dykman, no sample survey for sites that may be impacted by the effects of subsidence will be required for this mine.
- 3) An historical report will be submitted to the regulatory authority confirming the lack of significance of the previous mining facilities.

Pinnacle Mine Plan (UT 0022)

- 1) No additional general cultural resources overview will be required.
- 2) The names of the principal investigators have been supplied.
- 3) No sample survey for cultural resources that may be impacted by the effects of subsidence will be required.

Braztah #3, Price River Coal Company (UT 0008)

The cultural resources originally protected by stipulation are not eligible for nomination to the National Register of Historic Places, and thus no longer need protection.
