Tom Tetting and Gilbert Hunt of the Division met on site with Rob Wiley and Gene Haub of PRCC June 19, 1981. A tour of their present activity on site was given as well as an inspection of their proposed power line corridor. Work was in progress on culvert emplacement and shaft construction. Their soil stockpile has been consolidated and bermed at the mouth of the canyon. Proposed construction of a new leach field modification to their waste treatment facility was pointed out as it has not been indicated on their mine plan. The power line corridor appears to be chosen along the line of least impact to vegetation and wildlife. It seems well chosen.

As a member of the technical staff, I feel that a certain amount of rapport can be achieved with the operator as an intermediary between them and Inspection and Enforcement. This was capitalized upon during this visit.
