Dear Rob,

This letter is to reaffirm our conversation of this morning during which time, your request to notify your road construction contractor two weeks prior to actual initiation of activity was granted with reservations. Primarily, it should be understood on your part that during this two week period, the Division of Oil, Gas and Mining will attempt to complete its Declaration of Completeness of the Crandall Canyon Modification and coordinate this review with OSM; however, it may possibly run past this deadline (November 5) and thus prolong construction activity.

The present status of review of the project is as follows; information concerning the road construction has been reviewed by the Division, but not by OSM. The recent partial response by PRCC on October 14 to the ACR completed on July 20, 1981 has been sent via Federal Express to OSM for review with a request that the road be reviewed first. The Division is progressing with its Determination of Completeness on the ACR. It is not yet possible to determine when OSM will schedule their technical review.

Additional three items need to be clarified.

1. Leach field, waste disposal plans and maps need to be submitted to OSM (c/o Shirley Lindsey).

3. The Department of State Health needs to review the point source discharge plans discussed between Sally Kefer and yourself Friday, October 23. Please indicate whether or not this information has been supplied. It particularly involves the oil sump installation.

Please continue to update the Division as to the status of information submittal plans.
