Pursuant to our phone conversation concerning the status of Violation group #81-3-2-6 issued to Price River Coal Company February 4, 1981, the following information has been provided for your records.

Violation #1--terminated March 3, 1981.

Violation #2--extension granted on March 3, 1981 to May 5, 1981. Modification issued June 10, 1981. Final abatement date resulting from noncompliance allowed during UMW strike would be July 24, 1981.

Violation #3--extension granted on February 9, 1981 to April 5, 1981. Allowable time lapse as a result of the UMW strike would put the final time to June 24, 1981.

Violation #4--vacated May 28, 1981.


Violation #5--terminated March 13, 1981.

Violation #6--terminated March 13, 1981.

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At this time, the Division requests documentation indicating that the UMW strike is, in fact, over and that miners under the ABC contract may return to work at Price River Coal Company. If there are matters pending that would prohibit miners returning to work, please contact the Division so that we may ascertain proper abatement time for Violations #2 and 3 of violation group #81-3-2-6. Please be advised that no mining activities may occur until the requirements contained in Violation #2 have been met. Please contact the Division if you have any questions.
