Dear Mr. Wiley:

Pursuant to Notice of Violation #N81-3-2-6, No. 3 of 6 and 4 of 6, the Division hereby grants approval for said operator to initiate compliance measures at the Crandall Canyon egress area. Options for abatement measures include the following:

- Option A. Remove all equipment and material from the area. Remove the top six inches of topsoil or surficial material and implement sediment control structures.
- Option B. Remove all equipment and material from the area and reclaim the affected egress area. Reclamation efforts should include, but are not limited to, grubbing and/or removal of all vegetative material, removal of all foreign material and potential contaminants, scarification, seed bed preparation, seeding, mulching, crimping and addition of soil supplements to aid in revegetation success. In any event, all equipment and material must be removed from the affected area immediately.
