
Dear Mr. Tetting:

We wish to pick up and transport up to 45,000 yds.³ of earth materials from upper pad development in Crandall Canyon, and potentially 5-7,000 yds.³ from the access road/Route 6 intersection, for temporary storage and future use as a refuse covering material or, if suitable, substitute resoiling medium.

Storage will be either on the preparation plant site or on the Willow Creek area near the temporary "heliport" area. Both areas have existing and functional drainage controls.

We hope that our intent to do this causes no "concerns" with your staff. If we do not hear from you, we will proceed as planned.


