On Friday October 15, Tom Tetting, Jim Smith, Lynn Kunzler and Joe Lyons from the Division met with Floyd Johnson of the Office of Surface Mining (OSM) and two previously contracted representatives from the consulting firm of Fred Hart (Denver). The meeting took place at a motel in Price and concerned a discussion of the recent draft review by the consultant of Price River Coal Company's (PRCC) response to the ACR.

Afterwards, an on-site technical tour was conducted by Rob Wiley and Ken Hutchenson from PRCC. The Consultants were familiarized with the various sites involved with the mining operations; the No's 3, 4, 5 portal facilities, the prep plant, Crandall, Willow, Schoolhouse and Barn Canyons. The on-site visit as well as the meeting and discussion of the operation with PRCC should have proved to be an invaluable aid in the review process.
