RE: Diversion Around Utah Fuel #1
Portal
Price River Coal Company Complex
ACT/007/004
Carbon County, Utah

In an October 5, 1982 phone conversation, Joe Lyons of the Division and Rob Wiley of Price River Coal Company discussed the concerns of the Division in regards to this proposed diversion. Specifically, these concerns are: revegetation seed mix; reclamation of topsoil; and, drainage considerations. These concerns have been addressed by Price River Coal Company in the following ways: revegetation seed mix--addressed in the Price River Coal Company MRP; topsoil reclamation--addressed in an October 1 letter from Rob Wiley to Ev Hooper of the Division; drainage concerns--discrepancies in the submitted modification proposal were discussed by Joe Lyons and Rob Wiley in their phone conversation. Specifically, these discrepancies involve the submitted cross section drawing of the diversion. The cross-section area should be six (6) square feet, not five (5) square feet as shown in Attachment III of modification proposal. Also, the bank cut above the diversion will be contoured back to a nonerosive slope in areas of high erosion potential. Division approval for this modification is based upon this discussion and previous verification of design suitability of the diversion.
