On September 28, 1982, these proposed modification sites were visited by Joe Lyons, Lynn Kunzler, Ev Hooper, Tom Tetting, Cy Young and Tammy Balkenbush of the Division. Price River Coal Company employees Rob Wiley and Don Stephens accompanied the Division personnel on the field tour. At the Utah Fuel Portal #1, existing drainage and erosion problems were observed and discussed and the proposed diversion described. At the Schoolhouse Canyon refuse disposal site, the extent of increased storage volume for each of three proposed alternatives was described and the existing drainage diversion examined. A brief stop at the Crandall Canyon Facilities to observe on-going construction concluded the field visit. Upon returning to the Price River Coal Company offices, a discussion of regulatory requirements for the proposed Schoolhouse Canyon refuse disposal modification was undertaken. Each Division specialist commented on the information that would be required in the modification proposal in regards to their area of interest.
