Dear Mr. Wiley:

The Division has reviewed the bond status for Price River Coal Company's Price River Complex under the interim mining permit and found that the bond amount is not adequate for the number of disturbed acres (as required by 40-10-15 and UMC 800.11). Therefore, an adequate amount must be posted with the Division within sixty (60) days to cover interim reclamation costs until such time as the Division can finalize the review of your permanent permit application and a final bond estimate can be posted. This amount can be estimated by determining the number of acres of surface disturbance and multiplying this acreage by \$5,000 (a low estimate per acre).

The amount to be posted should be:

130 Acres X \$5,000/acre = \$650,000.00

Price River Coal Company has posted the amount of \$350,000.00; a difference of \$300,000.00 should be submitted.
