RE: Division Inspection for Bond Release at Price River  
Coal Company "Goose Island" Reclamation Project

Attached is a request by Price River Coal Company for a release of a portion of their reclamation bond. In accordance with the recently adopted UMC bonding regulations (UMC 800.40[b][1]), the "Division shall, within 30 days, or as soon as weather conditions permit, conduct an inspection and evaluation of the reclamation work involved." This inspection should be conducted by July 11, 1985.

After that time, within 60 days from the filing of the bond release application (August 10, 1985), the Division must notify interested parties of its decision to release or not to release all or part of the performance bond.

Price River Coal hereby applies for release of a portion of total reclamation bond, under UMC 807.12(b)(1).

The amount of release is \$89,705 of the total (in effect when published in newspaper - later increased) amount of \$2,532,857. The amount is calculated as follows:

$$8.33 \text{ ac} \div 141 \text{ ac} \times 0.6 \times \$2,532,857 = \$89,705$$
