Dear Ms. Linner:

Dave Darby has asked me to respond to your letter requesting work on Condition #6 of the permit by 25 July, 1986.

As you know, I had originally scheduled for Dave and I to go into the active area of No. 5 Mine on July 9, 1986, to inspect for significant aquifers. However, since that time Dave and I chose the 9 July date, the mine manager has informed me that he would not have anyone available to take Dave and I into the mine. The reason for this lack of personnel to escort us into the mine is the recent scheduling of Safety and Management training for the mine. Since I am not yet qualified to go into the mine alone, MSHA regulations would require that a third qualified person accompany us on the inspection.

During the next three weeks, I will be unavailable for an inspection because of training and my moving from Indianapolis to Price. Therefore, Dave and I have agreed to another date of 19 August to inspect the mine for significant aquifers.
