Re: Conditional Approval, MRP Amendment, Drainage Control  
Modifications in Hardscrabble Canyon, Price River Complex,  
ACT/007/004-I, Folders No. 3 and 4, Carbon County, Utah

On April 21, 1986, the Division sent a conditional approval to Price River Coal Company for a MRP Amendment to modify drainage controls in Hardscrabble Canyon. The condition required that Price River Coal (Castle Gate Coal) submit plans for an energy dissipator at the outlet of Diversion 3-A as it enters diversion D-5 at least 15 days prior to commencement of construction of the drainage control modifications. As of September 9, 1986, the Division has not received the energy dissipator designs.

As construction of the modifications has already commenced, the Division requests that the energy dissipator designs be submitted immediately. Castle Gate Coal Company is not in compliance with the term of the conditional approval until these designs have been submitted and reviewed by the technical staff.
