RE: Review of Unit Train Loadout Facility As-Built Plans, Castle Gate Coal Company, Castle Gate Mine Complex, ACT/007/004, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah.

A review of the above referenced plan was completed after receiving page two (2) of the plan on March 17, 1988.

With regards biological resources information and plans, the plan can generally be considered complete and technically adequate. However the revegetation portion needs to be clarified as discussed below:

UMC 784.13(b)(5)(i) & (ii) - lk

The seedling plan at the bottom of page 4 needs to be modified to identify the number of narrow-leaf cottonwood seedlings (five gallon containerized stock) that will be planted on the disturbed area. Also, the plan states that disturbed areas will be seeded in the fall of 1987. If this was not done, CGCC should submit a brief statement as to why it was not done and provide a revised schedule to the Division for approval.
