Only one major engineering issue appears to be deficient in the applicant's proposal.

UMC 817.171 Roads: Class III: Location - JRH

In order to meet the requirements of this section, the operator must mark the location of the roads in the field prior to approval of the application. To meet these requirements, the Division must stipulate the approval as follows:

Condition - UMC 817.171 - (1) - JRH

Within thirty (30) days prior to construction of any Class III roads to be used in conjunction with coal degasification well sites, the operator shall clearly mark in the field, the location of the roads to be constructed, and shall notify the Division for approval of the location of the roads. No Class III road shall be constructed until such time as the Division has inspected and approved the location of the road in the field.
