
Dear Dr. Nielson:

The purpose of this letter is to inform the Division that Castle Gate Coal Co. will suspend operations on June 5, 1989. This is an indefinite temporary suspension of operations as defined under UMC 817.131.

During the period of suspended operations, Castle Gate Coal will comply with all provisions of the approved permit such as water quality monitoring, water treatment and maintenance of environmental structures.

The data sent to the Division for the mid-term permit review defines the horizontal and vertical extent of the subsurface strata, which has been in the permit area prior to cessation of mining. } *
