RE: Determination of Administrative Completeness, Five Year Permit Renewal, Castle Gate Coal Company, Castle Gate Complex, ACT/007/004, Folder #2, Carbon County, Utah

SUMMARY:

The operator's Mining and Reclamation Plan (MRP) submitted for the 5 year permit renewal on June 23, 1989, has been reviewed by the Division regarding hydrologic completeness issues. As per an agreement between the Division administration and Castle Gate Coal Company (CGCC) representatives (Nov. 15, 1989 meeting), this review addresses "administrative" completeness issues which have not been included in any portion of the submitted MRP. It is important to note that many technical completeness deficiencies remain unresolved at this time and will be included in a forthcoming Technical Deficiency review.

ANALYSIS:

UMC 783.25 Cross-Sections, Maps, and Plans - MMD

Section 3.5-3 refers to Exhibit 11-7 for the as-built configuration of Pond 010. This exhibit was not located in the submittal. The operator must submit an accurate as-built drawing of Pond 010 as required by this regulation and as per the requirements enumerated in UMC 817.46 and UMC 817.49.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

The Division recommends that upon receiving an as-built drawing of pond 010 the submitted MRP be determined "administratively" complete.
